ONLINE INTERACTIVE INSTRUCTIONS:

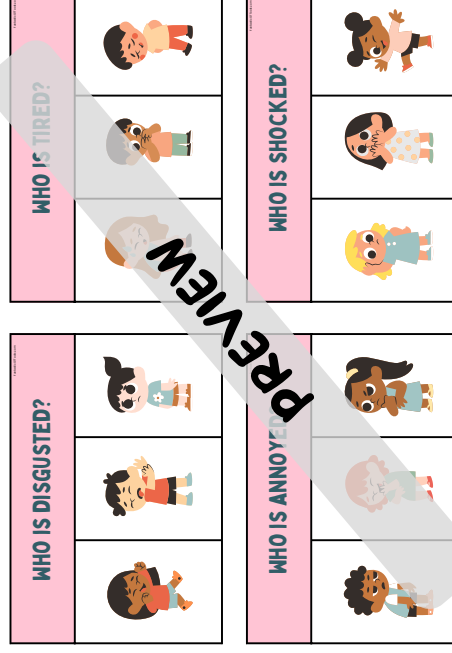
- OPTION 1 (Adobe Account Holders):

 - Open PDF Preview > View > Markup Toolbar > Draw

 - Open word doc > Drag PDF into word doc > Draw > Select color to draw

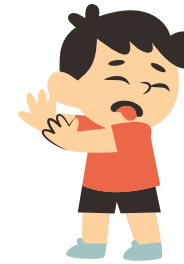
